- Manager and Mayor gave update on the iguana hunter situation on the C51 canal; it remains unclear as to SFWMD policies regarding hunting iguanas on their easement; More information to follow. Manager will extend gratitude to Commissioner Weiss's office and staff for their timely response to this issue.
- Manager reminded Council of qualifying dates.
- Council Member Sullivan inquired re: code situation at 1275 Taylor; Manager reported not having seen yellow box truck for over two weeks and that the owner seems now to be in compliance with code.
