PBSO/PBCFR MONTHLY REPORT

PBSO: Deputy Schnell submitted the following report for the past month

<u>PBC F/R</u>: Craig Spiegelhalter introduced himself as temporary replacement for Tracey Adams who is on medical leave. There were 3 calls in Glen Ridge in October (1 EMS, 1 Alarm, 1 Illegal Burn). For September there were 4 calls (3 EMS, 1 Alarm). He announced that a 2nd rescue vehicle will be stationed at Station 33, which serves Glen Ridge.
