NEW BUSINESS

- Ordinance 2023-2 given first reading; multiple changes were made that will be included for second reading; (Sullivan/Hadden, M/S/C, unanimously).
- Upon discussion, Taylor Jantz was appointed by the Council to complete the term of Jim Ussery who resigned the post. (Hadden/Sullivan, M/S/C unanimously).
- Manager reported Code Enforcement activity: Special Magistrate hearings on 10/11/23 for the properties at 4030 Gem Lake and 1255 Taylor Rd.; NOV to be sent to 1320 Glen Rd (Boat); Friendly reminders to 1302 Chandler and 1405 Glen Rd. (Intersection shrubbery).
- Council discussed the annual election caucus. Motion made to eliminate same. (Hadden/Sullivan, M/S/C unanimously).
- Council granted support of the amendments to the HUD Interlocal Cooperation Agreement. (Hadden/Sullivan, M/S/C).
- Manager gave a report of a meeting with PBC Water Utilities in re: preliminary steps for septic
 to sewer conversion; Rough estimates of costs were provided. WUC will send a more detailed
 and exact report of costs within the next several weeks.
- Council approved the Manager's request to hire an hourly employee to handle Public Works duties in the Town. \$2500 per year allotment was approved. (Hadden/Sullivan, M/S/C unanimously).
- Mayor McLane responded to questions submitted by Taylor Jantz, which had been covered earlier by the Manager. These dealt with numerous topics, including park, speed bumps, signs, etc.
- Council Member Sullivan reported an encounter with a dirt bike after dark operating with no lights. He was advised to call PBSO.
- Further discussion ensued regarding issues on Taylor Rd. Residents were again reminded to call PBSO to report any suspicious activity.
- Mayor McLane reported that the PBSO deputy assigned to Glen Ridge will be going on light duty.
 Manager will express request that a different deputy be assigned to the Town rather than relying on email reports to the Manager.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GLEN RIDGE, FLORIDA, ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO ITS ZONING CODE TO PROVIDE FOR A SPECIAL EXCEPTION CATEGORY FOR SELF-STORAGE FACILITIES, TO AMEND THE PARKING CODE TO CREATE A CATEGORY FOR SELF-STORAGE FACILITIES, PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Town of Glen Ridge has a Zoning Code in Appendix "A" which allows uses of property from single family to commercial; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Glen Ridge has a Zoning Code which allows Special Exceptions in Section 5.1.6 (2); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Glen Ridge has the power to change, add or remove Special Exceptions in Section 5.1.6 (2); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Glen Ridge is amending the list of Special Exceptions in Section 5.1.6 (2) to provide an allowance for Self-Storage Facilities within the Commercial Zoning District; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GLEN RIDGE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The foregoing Recitals are hereby ratified as true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. The Town of Glen Ridge Zoning Code hereby amends the Zoning Code to allow Self-Storage Facilities as an allowable Special Exception in the C-1 Commercial District as an addition to the Special Exception uses in Section 5.5.3 and

provide other criteria and requirements related to such uses (deleted language is stricken through; new language is underlined."

ARTICLE V. ZONING DISTRICTS, MAP AND SCHEDULE OF REGULATIONS

* * * * * * *

Section 5.5. – C-1 district: specialized commercial

* * * * * * *

5.5.3 Special exceptions.

- (1) Billboards.
- (2) Telecommunications antennas.
- (3) Schools, Elementary and Secondary
 - a) Schools shall be located and buffered to ensure compatibility with neighboring uses and development.
 - b) Site design shall include adequate vehicle stacking such that all loading and unloading of passengers occurs on site and does not extend into public roads.
 - c) Site design shall provide required parking to serve the maximum capacity of School at build out.
 - d) Outside activity areas shall provide setbacks and buffering adequate to minimize potential adverse impacts on adjacent residential areas.
 - e) Outdoor activities shall be limited to daylight hours, excepting occasional school related activities as approved by the Town Council by voice vote.

Section 6.1. – Miscellaneous regulations.

* * * * * * *

Section 6.1.10. Self-Service Storage

- a) Self-Service Storage uses shall maintain hours of operation between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Monday thru Saturday and between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Sunday
- b) There shall be no outdoor storage of goods permitted on-site.

- c) There shall be no business conducted or operated from a storage unit.
- d) <u>Units shall be accessed internally within the building from a specified loading</u> zone.

SECTION 3. The Town of Glen Ridge Zoning Code hereby amends the ARTICLE VII. OFF-STREET PARKING REGULATIONS in Section7.1.5 to change number (5) Reserved to Self Storage Facilities and be Five (5) spaces (deleted language is stricken through; new language is underlined."

ARTICLE VII. OFF-STREET PARKING REGULATIONS

* * * * * * *

Section 7.1.5. – Parking space requirements. The number of required off-street parking spaces in all districts for every residential, recreational, institutional, cultural, business or public use shall be provided in accordance with the following minimum requirements:

(1)	Dwelling units	Two per unit.
(2)	Reserved.	
(3)	Medical offices and clinics	One for every 200 square feet of gross floor area.
(4)	Schools, Elementary and Secondary	1 space per employee, 1 visitor space for every 50 students, 1 space for every 5.5 students in 11 th and 12 th grade; Auditorium or stadium – 1/3 seats
(5)	Reserved. Self-Service Storage Facility.	<u>5 spaces</u>
(6)	Reserved.	
(7)	Professional offices, business services, personal services and other permitted commercial uses	One for every 300 square feet of gross floor area.
(8)	Barbershops and beauty parlors	One for every 200 square feet of gross floor area.

SECTION 4. The Town Council hereby authorizes the Town Manager to transmit this Ordinance to the Municipal Code Corporation to include it in the Town of Glen Ridge Zoning Code.

SECTION 5. If any clause, section or other part of this Ordinance shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered as eliminated and in no way affecting the validity of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. That all ordinances or parts or ordinances, resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict hereby, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and adoption.
